I can't deny that the ideas in the book sound tantalizing, but in the end the author abandons his responsibility to his audience. The book is really an ambiguous ramble about philosophies and theories that he often just leaves floating around and forgotten. He presents his ideas for himself and talks down to his audience. He needs to learn that the message isn't about him, it's about the audience. For example, he provides no means for readers to reference any of his supporting source material, just assumes that they all know what that material should be and where to find it. Even the most elite of scholarly publications and discussions, where people are well-studied about the concepts of discussion, don't do this. They always provide citation so that their audience can access the source of information the author refers to. This is part of making this kind of message interactive for the reader. While it is the author's responsibility to conduct his own research and cite his sources in a way that the reader can reference them, he dumps all that responsibility on the reader instead. Books that present conspiracy theories provide more citations of their evidence than this book does. We have to take the author at his word that something he said is true.

For this reason, this book is not suited for anyone who would like to validate or verify any of his opinions here.
